This section describes the offerings made to the various hallows, the Kindred and the attendees of the rite.

• Guardian/Thor: Mead (if available), else beer

• Nerthus: Grain

• Fire: Herbs (Sage)

• Well: Silver the well

• Tree: Water from the well

• Heimdall: Mead (if available), else beer

• Landvaettir: Incense (sage from garden, if available)

• Ancestors: Bread

• AEsir/Vanir: Cheese

• Freyr: Pork (boar) sausage

• Freyja: Apple

• Final Sacrifice: portion of the ritual feast

• Waters of Life: Water from bowl used for purification

• Sumbl: Mead

• Ritual feast: Apples, bread & butter, sausage, cheese

## 2 Initiating the Rite (Dale)

 $\{Speaker\}:$ 

Welcome! We welcome all that will join with us today, and may the Kindred's bless our rite.

{Speaker}: Sounds the horn three times and leads the procession out to the fire {All}: Sing

#### 4 Purification (Jeremiah)

{Speaker}: Takes the bowl of holy water from the altar

Let this water cleanse us.

Let it wash away our doubts, our worldly concerns and purify us so we may stand in the presence of the Shining Ones.

{Speaker}: Anoints the participants. {Speaker}: Leads the group on a brief Two Powers meditation.

## 5 Honoring the Earth Mother (Mary)

{Assistant 1}: Walks around with with bowl of grain for participants to take {Assistant 2}: Following Assistant 1, walks once around the congregation with the veiled picture while Nerthus is honored {Speaker}:

Oh Goddess Nerthus, veiled one, Earth Mother, we give praise and offerings to you on this day. We thank you for support in our lives and in our rituals. We are the children of your Earth. We remember and honor you.

Nerthus, we call to you and ask for your presence and support in our working today.

## 6 Statement of Purpose (Dale)

 $\{Speaker\}:$ 

This evening we gather together as one people to worship the old gods. We honor Freyr and Freyja, who have gifted Midgard with their fertility. They have helped bring abundance into our world and our lives and now we give our praise and thanks to them.

The autumnal equinox is an agrarian celebration. Our ancestors would come together to harvest and preserve their crops. They would be repairing their homesteads to stand against the trials of winter. Much as have done, we still do. We harvest and preserve our crops and we prepare ourselves, and our homes for winter.

We also are celebrating the changing of the seasons. The world is in a time of balance, but moving into the dark half of the year. Look at the people around you, we stand together as one people, our self chosen community.

As the world grows darker, let us rekindle the light of the sun within ourselves and our community!

## 7 Recreating the Cosmos (Jeremiah)

{Sacrificer}: Gives herbs to the fire and moves to the tree

Let the water from the well of Mimir sanctify this wood.

Transform now to Yggdrasil. Through you the 9 realms are connected.

{Speaker}: Gives offering of water from the well to the tree and speaks

We are gathered here, in Midgard, at the base of Yggdrasil.

Alfar and Disir, accept this offering.

{Speaker}: Places offering next to the Well

You who are of our blood and bone, you who are of our spirit and heart, you who have walked this world and left it before us.

We honor you.

#### 9.3 Inviting the Gods

 $\{Speaker\}:$ 

Welcome AEsir and Vanir!

We make space at our fire for the gods of our people, and the gods of this land. Gods, goddesses, accept this offering.

{Speaker}: Pours offering into the fire

You who nurture our spirits, you who challenge us to grow, you who we return to when we pass from this world.

{Speaker}: Call

We remember you.

{All}: Response

We honor you.

Repeat Call/Response for a total of 3 times

## 10 Key Offerings (Dale)

{All}: give praise offerings {Speaker}: Speaks and places offering in the fire

Hail Freyr, riding from Álfheimr to Midgard on your dwarf made boar Gullinbursti. Hail to you, the most loved of the gods. Hail to you bringer of abundance. Freyr, welcome to our fire and accept our offering!

{Speaker}: Speaks and places offering in the fire

Hail Freyja, riding in on your cat drawn chariot. Hail to you bringer of magic and chooser of the battle slain. Hail to you, bringer of passion and pleasure. Freyja, welcome to our fire and accept our offering!

It is through Freyr and Freyja that fertility has come to our land. Look around and see the fruits of the land that have ripened since they were sewn in the spring.

## 11 Prayer of Sacrifice (Dale)

{Speaker}: Picks up offering tray

Before us is an offering of our harvest. Tone your gratitude, your praise for the many blessings we have received into this offering.

{Speaker}: Walks around with the offering

{Speaker}: Speaks and leaves offerings at the edge of the Nemeton

Frayr and Frayja, accept our offering!

#### 12 The Omen (Mary)

{Speaker}: To the oracle

Oracle, were our offerings accepted?

{Oracle}: Draws and interprets the omen

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{Speaker 1}:
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We have given our worship and have been blessed this day by the Kindred. As we move about in our lives, remember that all the worlds are connected through Yggdrasil, and the blessings of the Kindred flow within you.

Freyr and Freyja, we thank you for sharing our fire, and may the crops you blessed sustain us though the dark half of the year.

## 18 Closing the Gates (Jeremiah)

#### 19 Thanking the Earth Mother (Mary)

Nerthus, we begin with you and end with you. Thank you for being with us at our ritual.

Let all that has not been offered, be offered unto you.

{Speaker}: All unsacrificed offerings, not part of the ritual meal, are now given to Nerthus {Speaker}: Speaks, then empties the well onto the earth.

From you came this water, and unto you this water shall return.

## 20 Closing the Rite (Dale)

 $\{Speaker\}:$ 

We have come together as one people to worship the Kindred as our ancestors did and as our children will do. May we part in peace, understanding and compassion until we next worship together.

This ritual is complete! Let us now Feast!

{All}: Complete the ritual meal with the Kindred by eating the food that was first gifted to them.

{Speaker}: When all worshipers have completed eating, some of the remaining food can be distributed to the animals.
