- Shining Ones AEsir/Vanir: Cheese
- Deity of the Occasion Freyr: Pork (boar) sausage
- Deity of the Occasion Freyja: Apple
- Final Sacrifice: portion of the ritual feast
- Waters of Life: Mead

1 Initiating the Rite (Dale)

$\{Speaker\}:$

Welcome! We welcome all that will join with us today, and may the Kindred's bless our rite.

{Speaker}: Sounds the horn three times and leads the procession out to the fire {All}: Sing "We Approach the Sacred Grove"

2 Outdwellers (Rick)

{Speaker}: Makes offering to the Outdwellers

Hail Thor! Weilder of Mjölnir, enemy of the Midgard Serpent, vanquisher of giants, we ask you to guard our ritual. To hold at bay the Jotuns; those who would disrupt our worship, those who act outside our best interests.

Jotuns, beware this day and do not trouble our rite, for amongst us is a mighty warrior of our gods.

Thor, protector of Midgard, accept our offering and aid us.

3 Purification (Lisa)

{Speaker}: Takes the bowl of holy water from the altar

Let this water cleanse us.

Let it wash away our doubts, our worldly concerns and purify us so we may stand in the presence of the Shining Ones.

4 Honoring the Earth Mother (Laura & Rick)

{Assistant 1}: Walks around with with bowl of grain for participants to take {Assistant 2}: Following Assistant 1, walks once around the congregation with the veiled picture while Nerthus is honored {Speaker}:

Oh Goddess Nerthus, veiled one, Earth Mother, we give praise and offerings to you on this day. We thank you for support in our lives and in our rituals. We are the children of your Earth. We remember and honor you.

Nerthus, we call to you and ask for your presence and support in our working today.

5 Statement of Purpose (Dale)

 $\{Speaker\}:$

This evening we gather together as one people to worship the old gods. We honor Freyr and Freyja, who have gifted Midgard with their fertility. They have helped bring abundance into our world and our lives and now we give our praise and thanks to them.

The autumnal equinox is an agrarian celebration. Our ancestors would come together to harvest and preserve their crops. They would be repairing their homesteads to stand against the trials of winter. Much as they have done, we still do. We harvest and preserve our crops and we prepare ourselves, and our homes for winter.

We also are celebrating the changing of the seasons. The world is in a time of balance, but moving into the dark half of the year. Look at the people around you, we stand together as one people, our self chosen community.

As the world grows darker, let us rekindle the light of the sun within ourselves and our community!

6 Recreating the Cosmos (Dale)

 $\{Speaker\}: Speaks$

At the dawn of time there was the Ginnungagap, an empty void that divided Musphelheim, the realm of primordial fires, from Niflheim, the realm of eternal ice and snow. Over time, the flames crossed the gap, melted the ice, and formed steam. The steam filled the gap, and from it arose the first beings, and eventually the gods. They then created the reaming realms. Asgard, which is the realm of the Æsir. Vanaheimr, which is the realm of the Vanir. Álfheimr, which is the realm of the elves. Svartálfaheimr, which is the realm of the dwarves. Jötunheimr, which is the realm of the giants. Helheimr, which is the realm of the dead. Finally there is Midgard, the realm of humans.

Growing between Niflheim and Musphelheim is the great tree Yggdrasil. It grows and entwines all the realms within it roots and branches.

Hail Freyr, riding from Álfheimr to Midgard on your dwarf made boar Gullinbursti. Hail to you, the most loved of the gods. Hail to you bringer of abundance. Freyr, accept our offering!

{Laura}: Speaks and places offering in the fire

Hail Freyja, riding in on your cat drawn chariot. Hail to you bringer of magic and chooser of the battle slain. Hail to you, bringer of passion and pleasure. Freyja, accept our offering!

It is through Freyr and Freyja that fertility has come to our land. Look around and see the fruits of the land that have ripened since they were sewn in the spring.

Take a moment and reflect upon the bounty that you have been given.

You may make offerings to Freyr, Freyja, or any other Kindred at this time.

10 Prayer of Sacrifice (Lisa)
