### 2 Initiating the Rite (Dale/Lisa)

{Singer}: We Approach the Sacred Grove by Sean Miller {Speaker}: Speaks

Once again we have gathered together as one people, to honor our Kindred and celebrate the changing of the seasons.

Around us the spirits of nature move, amongst us our ancestors gather and before us our gods stand tall.

#### 4 Outdwellers (Jason)

{Speaker}: Speaks then gives offering to Thor

Jotuns, beware this day and do not trouble our rite, for amongst us is a mighty warrior of our gods.

Thor, protector of Midgard, accept our offering and aid us.

#### 5 Purification (Ronald)

{Speaker}: Walks around the circle playing the singing bowl, while speaking

Let the sound go through your body, your bones, and your being. Let it bring you in tune with your surroundings. As the water falls on you may it bring peace and purity of purpose. We have made sacred this space that we may worship and honor the Kindred as one.

{Assistant}: Walking behind the speaker, asperge the attendees with a tree branch (or a bouquet of flowers) dipped in the well

# 6 Honoring the Earth Mother (Lisa)

{Assistant 1}: Walks around with with bowl of grain for participants to take {Assistant 2}: Walks once around the congregation with the veiled picture while Nerthus is honored {Speaker}:

Goddess Nerthus, veiled one, you once were carried around the countryside, as we carry an image of you around this circle.

 $\{Speaker\}:$ 

Shining Sunna, sister of Mani, driver of the chariot of the sun. You ride across the sky, illuminating the world, bringing warmth and growth to all living things. Today, you ride your highest in the sky, showing your strength and beauty! Radiant Sunna, goddess of the sun, you ride fast, for the wolf Skoll chases you, wishing to extinguish your life-giving light, but it is not this day. Today you shine strongest across all of Midgard, giving hope, life, and light to all.

Sunna, I honor you this day and ask that you be with us in our rite. Sunna accept this offering!
